What is the General Movements ?

General movements (GMs) can be observed in fetuses as young as nine weeks postmenstrual age. In infants without neurological dysfunction, GMs continue in a similar pattern until about the end of the second month postterm, which is then followed by a gradually emerging new GM pattern.
